"Herehaunui"

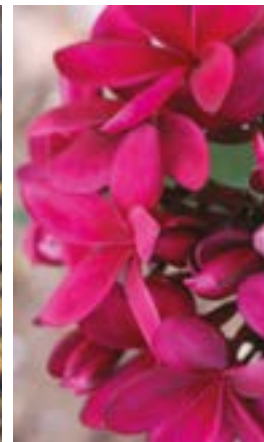
"Herehaunui" means "love and great peace". It is also the symbolic adopted name that was given to Guy Laliberté by the residents of the atoll of Nukutepipi.

One of the smallest atoll of the French Polynesia Tuamotu Archipelago and measuring approximately 5.6 km, surrounded by deep blue water and a unique ecosystem, Nukutepipi is a haven of rest and a lesson of humility, where all your senses will be challenged and inspired. It's a destination as true and authentic as you will ever find, and a retreat as exclusive as it can get. This luxury property offers a unique opportunity to experience unspoiled nature at its most grandiose while escaping in this one-of-a-kind hideaway. The island is only available for exclusive rental for groups of up to 50 people so you can have it all to yourself.





Where luxury meets nature

Nukutepipi is home to a unique collection of rare tropical flora and fauna, a primary forest, untouched beaches, a protected lagoon and natural coral reefs. The ongoing preservation and protection of its ecosystem is one of our proudest achievements, and we are fully dedicated to maintaining and sustaining a balance between the needs of the island's natural habitat and those of our guests.

In this particularly fragile place, the concept of an ecosystem takes all its value. Indeed, fauna, flora, micro-organisms and the natural elements are interdependent within an energy and material exchange network that ensures the maintenance, balance and development of the island.

Be moved by the beauty of this untouched paradise and let yourself be surrounded by a myriad of protected species, coconut palms and pristine beaches of emerald and crystalline turquoise waters. Nukutepipi is a true hymn to nature.

The location

Nukutepipi is located in the middle of the Pacific Ocean, less than 1,000 km from Bora Bora and Tahiti in French Polynesia. The closest international airport, Faaa, is located on Tahiti and can accommodate private jets.

There are year-round direct flights to Tahiti from Los Angeles, San Francisco, Honolulu, Paris, Tokyo and Auckland.

And a weekly flight from Santiago de Chile arrives in Tahiti via Easter Island.

Transfers to and from Tahiti (via Papeete domestic airport) to Nukutepipi are provided by private chartered flights. Once you reach the island, you'll be welcomed at the "Fare Fakariki" reception area with refreshments.

Things to do

Nukutepipi is a roughly triangular-shaped island measuring approximately 2.7 km in length. You can comfortably explore its incomparable scenery and breathtaking beauty on your own by foot, bike or even golf cart. Our dedicated team can provide an exclusive program to make sure you're comfortable and entertained as cherished Nukutepipi guests.

As an example, our stargazing program lets you explore the heavenly skies. You can also take advantage of unique bird watching opportunities or participate in our rich cultural activities including pareo making, pearl culture, introduction to local crafts, Tahitian dance and Polynesian tales and legends, in addition to discovering our bee colonies.

Nukutepipi's lagoon is a treasure trove for watersports and activities. The marine environment around Nukutepipi Island is truly diverse and unspoiled. You can snorkel or scuba dive in pristine waters or test your skills at deep-sea fishing as we have a prolific game bank nearby. Nukutepipi is also a dream destination for those wishing to swim with humpback whales. During the birthing season (July to November), you can closely observe, learn about and photograph these magnificent creatures.



On water

In the lagoon, you can practice snorkeling, paddleboarding, windsurfing, kite surfing, wake-boarding, kayaking, pedal boating and sailing. You can also experience lagoon tours, coral garden and nursery visits, reef walks, traditional sailing canoes, outrigger canoes Motu picnics and other motorized lagoon activities.

On sea, you can go deep-sea fishing, reef fishing, diving and even whale watching in season (July to November).





On land

Play tennis, badminton, beach volleyball, basketball, beach soccer, ping-pong, archery and mini putt. Discover the island on foot or by bike. Other unforgettable activities include bird watching, Frisbee, nature walks and fitness trails, javelin, hermit crab racing, star-gazing, Polynesian weaving and pareo dyeing, or learn about Polynesian tales and legends and watch traditional Tahitian dancers.



Indoors

Unwind in our luxurious spa, which offers two fully equipped massage rooms, a hammam, a Nordic bath, a sauna and an outdoor Jacuzzi. 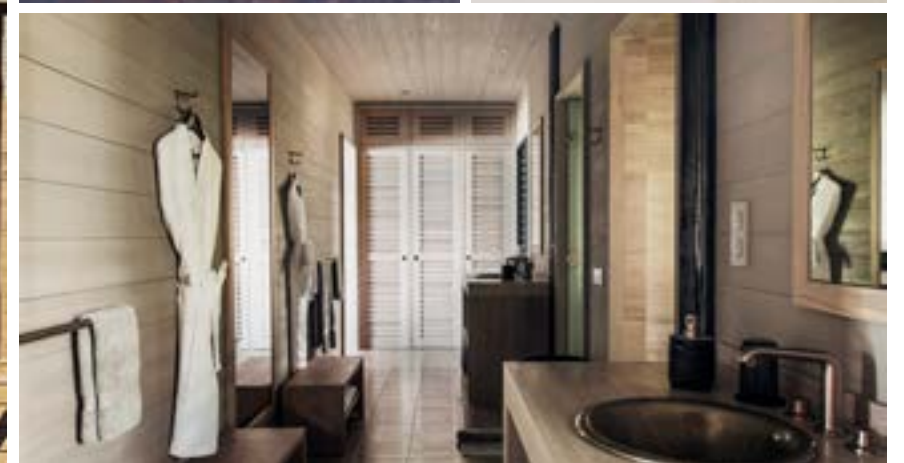

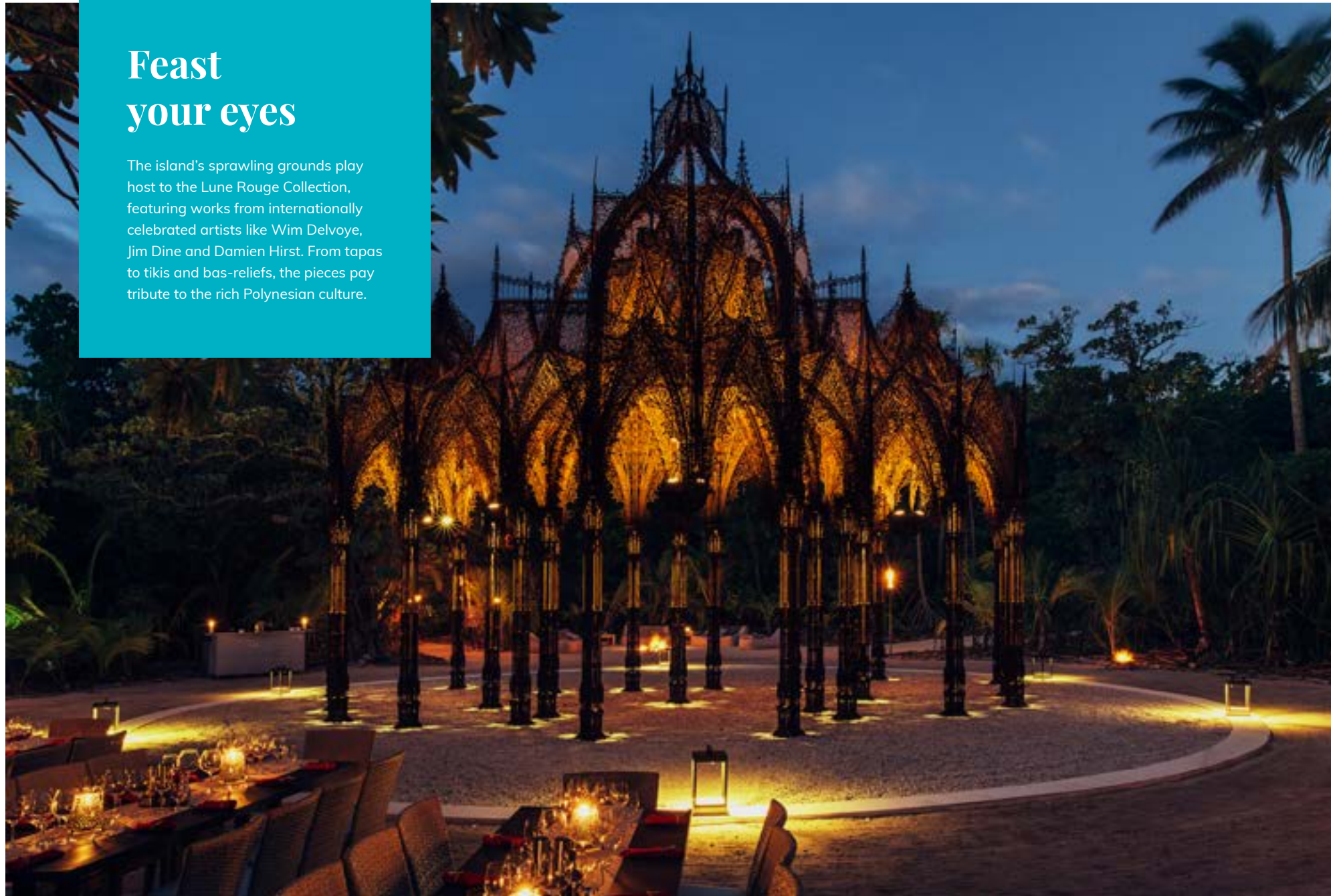
