ENERGY CONSERVATION

- The motu is self-sufficient in electricity up to 83 to 100% thanks to solar energy. Production of 48KWH, storage of 96KWh by lithium batteries.

RECYCLING AND WASTE REDUCTION

- Waste sorting according to the standards of the Community of Commune of Raiatea.
- Evacuation of all bulky and special waste according to the standards of the Community of Commune of Raiatea.
- Composting program with the help of an "Earthmaker" and a plant shredder.
- Elimination of plastic water bottles which are replaced by filtered water dispensers and free glass bottles and refillable water bottles.



WATER CONSERVATION

- Use of mulch to limit soil drying and therefore the need for irrigation
- Installation of flow restrictors on faucets

PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT

- Provision of coral-friendly sun care products
- Involvement in a turtle nesting monitoring and protection program
- To get around the island, guests use bicycles which reduces or eliminates the carbon emissions emitted during their trip.

HEALTHY, SUSTAINABLE AND RESPONSIBLE FOOD

- Production of plants and flowers in the Motu's vegetable garden used in the plates
- Production of our own eggs thanks to a team of 10 hens
- Promoting short circuits by buying as much as possible from local producers (fish, vegetables).
- Focus on local products, fresh, seasonal produce



SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- Improving employment opportunities on Raiatea/Tahaa and promoting territorial anchorage
- Encourage training to develop skills in the hotel sector
- Work with local providers in several sectors: excursions, transport, handcraft, cultural associations, etc.

WAYS TO GET GUESTS ENGAGED

- Guests are asked to reuse their towels a second time rather than tossing on the floor after one use. This cuts back on the energy and water used during laundering.
- Guests are encouraged to turn off lights when not in use and when they leaving the hotel room.
- Guests are encouraged to unplug all cell phone, laptop, or other chargers or electrical devices when not in use.
